INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Fit all parts before painting (See Special Instructions For Paint Prep.) Parts that have been installed, preped, or painted are not returnable.

NOTE:

Check fit all body parts PRIOR to paint. Follow urethane prep instructions before painting. Take your time and pre-fit all pieces so that they will have a tight fit to the body.

VERY IMPORTANT ! Read and understand all directions and check the following parts list before starting installation.

Phillips Screwdriver, Masking Tape

- 1. Tape the rear valance up to the body and mark it's location. Use masking tape for this.
- 2. Clean the paint area on body with a wax & grease remover.
- **3.** Clean the valance where the tape will contact it in the same way as on the body. Clean again. We can not stress the importance of cleaning.
- 4. Apply the adhesion promotor to the tape contact area and apply the two sided tape.
- **5.** Install the rear valance to vehicle making sure it is alligned properly. Install one screw in each rear wheel well thru the valance and into the fender lip.
- 6. If exhaust pipe has less than 3/4" clearance between pipe and valance, lower exhaust pipe as necessary.
